

Your HealthChoice Illinois Plan Choices

All plans have the same **basic** Medicaid services that you get now, such as:

- 24/7 nurse line
- Behavioral health services
- Doctor services
- Eye care services
- Hearing services
- Home health care
- Hospice care
- Hospital services
- Lab tests and x-rays
- Medical supplies
- Prescriptions
- Therapy
- Transportation to medically necessary appointments

All plans have extra benefits, such as **Care Coordinators** who will help you find the providers and services you need. Use this chart to compare the **extra** benefits and services that each health plan offers.

Important: If you receive Medicare benefits, Medicare will cover most of the services listed above. Your HealthChoice Illinois plan (Medicaid) will only cover:

- Your long term care services if you live in a nursing home or supportive living facility
- Your home and community based waiver services (such as the Aging or Physically Disabled waivers)
- Non-emergency transportation and some behavioral health services

Not all extra benefits will apply to you if you receive Medicare benefits. **Extra benefits marked with a diamond (◆) are available to enrollees with Medicare benefits.**

Practice visits

- Members with developmental disabilities or serious mental illness can go for practice visits to the dentist

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- You may qualify for:
 - A free car seat or portable crib by keeping one prenatal appointment during the first trimester of pregnancy
 - Two free packages of diapers for keeping postpartum appointments
 - A gift card for keeping at least six well child appointments

Transportation

- You can get a ride to the pharmacy or a medical equipment provider ◆

Vision

- You can get \$40 toward a pair of upgraded eyeglass frames every two years

Wellness

- You may qualify for:
 - Gift cards when you complete certain preventive services, like annual breast cancer screenings, in the Healthy Incentives program ◆
 - A free cell phone to call your doctor, care coordinator or 9-1-1 emergency services ◆
- You can get \$40 in OTC items by mail every three months ◆
- Members with diabetes can get in-home blood sugar test kits ◆
- You can get help to stop smoking
- You can get a free membership to Blue365, a program that offers health and wellness discounts

- Extra dental care for adults

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- You may qualify for:
 - Free packages of diapers for getting regular immunizations (shots)
 - \$10 to \$50 in rewards cards by keeping prenatal, postpartum and well child appointments and by getting regular immunizations (shots)
 - A Safe Sleep Survival Kit with a portable crib by keeping prenatal appointments
 - A free car seat or booster seat

Vision

- You may qualify for free LASIK eye surgery
- You can get \$100 toward eyeglasses or contact lenses every two years

Wellness

- You may qualify for reward cards when you complete certain preventive services, like annual health screenings ◆
- You can get free Weight Watchers® vouchers ◆
- Members aged 3 to 16 can join the Children and Toddlers' Book Club

- Extra dental care for adults

Pregnancy and healthy kids

- You may qualify for:
 - Up to \$130 on a prepaid My Health Pays® rewards card by keeping prenatal and postpartum appointments in the Start Smart for Your Baby® Program
 - A free car seat or diaper bag by keeping four prenatal appointments and going to a Healthy Mom, Healthy Baby event

Transportation

- You can get a ride to the pharmacy right after your doctor visit, or to a medical equipment provider
- New mothers can get a ride to Women, Infants and Children (WIC) food assistance sites for 30 days after baby's birth

Vision

- You can get \$100 toward eyeglasses or \$80 toward contact lenses every two years

Wellness

- You may qualify for:
 - Reward dollars on a My Health Pays® rewards card when you complete certain preventive services, like annual diabetic screenings
 - A free membership at partner gyms
 - A free cell phone to call your doctor, care coordinator or 9-1-1 emergency services in the Connections Plus program
 - Programs to help you manage diseases, such as depression, diabetes, and hypertension
- Members with diabetes or heart disease can get in-home test kits
- You can get help to stop smoking

- You may qualify for gift cards or a free baby stroller, high chair, or car seat by keeping prenatal and postpartum appointments in the Meridian Hugs program
